# **WELCOME TO BRANSON!**

The date of this year's reunion is Wednesday, September 17, through Sunday morning, September 21. We're in for a treat (or is it "re-treat") getting to visit one another in Branson, MO, this year. There is so much to do and see. The entertainment is plentiful; the scenery is beautiful! The officers have not scheduled a tour for Thursday of our visit. They hope you will take advantage of some of the great things Branson has to offer.

The tour for Friday is a 5-part tour. It should be great fun. We will enjoy riding the Ducks (land/water transportation), city tour, memorial service and a boat cruise with dinner and a show. It will be several hours of wonderful Branson.

Our hotel is the Radisson—the same hotel we enjoyed in 2002. It has recently been renovated and will prove to be very comfortable. It is conveniently located near the "strip" of restaurants, shows, and shopping. Andy Williams Theater and Kings Castle Theater are walking distance, as well as are 4 or 5 restaurants.

Registration is \$100 per person. This covers the Wednesday evening buffet, the Men's and Ladies' luncheons on Saturday, the Saturday dinner/dance and Sunday's farewell breakfast. Be sure to complete the registration form with the number of persons attending **each** of these meals.

The Radisson Hotel is located at 120 S. Wildwood Drive, Branson, MO, 65616. It is just off Hwy. 76W (Country Blvd.) Their phone number is 1-888-566-5290 or a direct number 1-417-335-5761. The room rate is \$93, plus tax. Please make reservations directly with the hotel; mention that you are with the *USS Antietam* Association. Be sure to request handicap and/or non-smoking rooms if applicable. They will need your arrival and departure dates and will give you a confirmation number. Cutoff date for rooms is August 18, 2014.

The nearest airports are in Springfield, MO (about 1 hour away), or the local Branson Airport. Cars can be rented in Springfield. Branson Airport is about 25 minutes away and offers a shuttle service to downtown for approximately \$30 one way. Current information may be gotten from the Branson Grayline, 1-417-332-2227. Local transportation (in town) will cost about \$5 per person each way. Complimentary parking is available on the hotel site.


#### REUNION SCHEDULE

#### CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY
